Offside - Interfering with an Opponent

In this game between Drexel (white) and St. Peter's (dark blue), Drexel is winning 1-0 when St. Peter's takes a shot that hits the crossbar and rebounds into play. A St. Peter's player shoots the ball on goal. St. Peter's #23 is in an offside position when the shot is taken and then runs toward the goalkeeper, eventually making contact with her as the ball goes past the goalkeeper and into the net for the tying goal. This play should have been ruled an offside infraction for interfering with an opponent. The match finished 1-1. If video review had been available for this match, the officials could have reviewed this play for an offside offense.
